Eligibility Criteria and Instructions

Title: Copywriting That Sells High-Tech

WriteSpark Press will donate one copy of this title to an eligible U.S. local public library or college/university library for inclusion in the library's publicly available book collection. Copies will be sent to eligible libraries on a first-requested, first-served basis while supplies last.

Eligibility: Your library must be in the United States and meet the following criteria to be considered for this program:

- A local public library, OR
- A college or university library in an institution that offers a degree or certificate program in advertising, marketing, technical communication, or technical writing.
- Your library must agree to place the donated book in your collection for patron checkout, for your normal retention period.

To request a copy for your library, send a request letter on the library's letterhead to:

The letter should include the shipping address and an e-mail address and telephone number for someone to contact if we have questions about your request.

All requests will be verified to confirm that the library qualifies to receive a copy of the book under this program. Only one copy of the book will be donated to each library or library system. All books will be donated at the discretion of WriteSpark Press.
